

Want to join the Village School Swim Team?

Please follow the below steps to ensure that you and your child have completed all necessary items and are fully prepared for the start of the swim program

1. All required athletic forms must be completed and submitted to the athletic offices for clearance. If you have not submitted these completed forms at this time, please visit our website to find copies of all forms at <u>http://www.teampages.com/organizations/2542/pages/99741</u>.

Required for High School Students

- Physical Evaluation and Physical Assessment Form
 Assessment MUST be completed and signed by a doctor
 - Concussion and Traumatic Brain Injury Form
- Sudden Cardiac Arrest Form
- TAPPS Parent and Student Notification Steroid Use Agreement Form
- TAPPS Student Acknowledgement of Rules Form
- TAPPS Transfer Form
 - If you are transferring to The Village School for the 2015-2016 academic school year and have already started 9th grade at a previous school, you will need to complete our TAPPS Transfer Form to be eligible
- Athletic Consent Form

Required for Middle School Students

- Physical Evaluation and Physical Assessment Form

- 2. Attend the swimming tryouts.

SWIMMING TRYOUT INFO

- <u>ALL</u> Students MUST have a physical on file to tryout.
 - Tryouts will occur over two days and will include the following events
 - 50 Freestyle
 - 0 100 IM
 - Additional Event TBD
- All parents attending tryouts should remain in lobby area and are not permitted to be on the pool deck.
- All swimmers that have been previously enrolled in ECS are not required to participate in the scheduled tryouts but are welcomed to attend if they would like to swim.

- 3. Ensure your child is registered as an active member of a swimming club.
 - To join Energy Core Swimming Club, please ensure you register for tryouts at <u>www.ecswimming.com</u>.
- 4. Ensure your child is registered with US Swimming, which should be completed through club registration.
 - \$75 per swimmer insurance/required USA Swimming membership fee
 - If registered through a club other than ECS, please provide USA Swimming # for verification
 - Monthly Pool & Coaching Fee of \$135 is required if not already a member of a USA Swimming registered club
 - There is no charge for attending the swimming tryout, however once a swimmer has made the team, billing will start and they will be charged for USA Registration at that time. For swimmers only participating during the Village Swim season, billing will occur November February.
- 5. Students interested in using Swimming for PE credit MUST complete OFF CAMPUS swimming form and follow the requirements associated. In order for students to qualify for this PE credit they MUST participate in a swim club program either semester 1 (August – December) and/or semester 2 (January – May) in its entirety. Students that only participate in TVS Swim program from October – February will not qualify for PE credit. Click <u>HERE</u> for the PE Credit Application.
- 6. Be sure to review all schedule details below and ensure that you are fully committed to the program.

Training Schedule

- TVS (in partnership with ECS) will be hosting a "team" practice ONE night per week once the season begins. ALL participants are required to attend in order to be eligible for TVS competitions.
 - High School Tentative Start Date (Oct 19th)
 - Middle School Tentative Start Date (Oct 26th)
- Team Practice Nights are TUESDAY evenings @ 7:30pm @ Westside High School
- Saturday Practice is also available at 12 PM for those who can attend.
- Transportation will only be provided to COMPETITION Swimming Meets only.

Competitive Schedule

- TVS will not have any dual meets this season but is in the process of scheduling participation in several Invitational.

 - 5-6 Invitational/US Swimming Meets
 - USA Swimming Meets
 - TAPPS Regional & State Championships (pending advancement)
- Middle School Schedule
 - 4-5 Invitational/US Swimming Meets
 - Meritas Games (Dec $1^{st} 5^{th}$) Orlando, FL
 - HJPC Championships
- TVS will supply students w/ suit and swim cap for all TVS swimming meets (no charge) TVS may support with additional "team wear" and issue these as a spirit pack w/ onetime fee.
- All transportation to meets will be provided by TVS.
